For more than 20 years, we have supported innovation, entrepreneurship and access to finance across Europe and internationally, managing innovation programmes worth more than €500 million in over 25 countries and participating in more than 100 EU-funded projects under Horizon Europe, Horizon 2020, Digital Europe, COSME, LIFE, Erasmus+, Interreg and other programmes.

Expertise in Open Innovation Programs and StartupGrowth. Cascade Funding/FSTP

We design and implement programmes that cover the full engagement cycle: corporate challenge definition, startup scouting, open calls, evaluation and selection, participant preparation, matchmaking, co-creation and pilot development. Our ecosystem includes more than 3,000 startups and scaleups, together with accelerators, investors, corporates and innovation hubs across Europe and other international markets.

Inneürope brings solid programme-management and operational capabilities. We have managed more than €6 million in cascade funding, evaluated over 500 applications, and supported approximately 150 funded projects and experiments. Through our WEGRANT platform, we support more than 60,000 companies and financial institutions in accessing public funding opportunities.

Across projects EU projects, we have also delivered services related to market uptake, business modelling, value proposition development, exploitation, go-to-market planning, stakeholder engagement, investment readiness and ecosystem building.

This approach has been applied also in international innovation programmes. Two relevant examples are the work with ADB (Asian Development Bank), and ATEFI (Asociación de Redes Latinoamericanas de Medios de Pago) where Inneürope has managed different open innovation challenges involving challenge definition, global startup scouting, technical assessment, one-to-one interviews, legal governance, intellectual property considerations and the development of an operational MVP.

Inneürope is connected to the European Digital Innovation Hub network, the European Startup Network, The Talent Route, and other international accelerator and startup ecosystems. These relationships provide direct access to entrepreneurs, innovation hubs, corporates and support organizations across Europe, Latin America, Asia and Africa.

This expertise is also supported by our track record as a long-standing Intermediary Organization for the Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs (EYE) program where we facilitate international entrepreneurial exchanges for new and aspiring entrepreneurs, as well as through our collaboration with 28Digital (formerly EIT Digital) as the sole Spanish partner for implementation of the Venture Incubation Program.

HumAlne (HORIZON)- ongoing

- **Training, exploitation and ecosystem building for human-centred AI.** Inneürope leads the HumAlne Training Centre, defining learning pathways for both technical and non-technical users around the project's exploitable results. We coordinate the creation of training materials by project partners, organize regular webinars to bring key exploitable results closer to wider audiences, and lead communication, exploitation, training and ecosystem-building activities, including stakeholder scouting, database management and stakeholder engagement tracking.

YEIM UP (SMP) – ongoing

- **Entrepreneurship support, business modelling and international exchange.** As Local Contact Point for the Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs program, Inneürope supports new entrepreneurs in preparing strong applications, developing business models, identifying suitable host entrepreneurs and managing the exchange process.
